Upper School Code of Conduct

The Side-By-Side "Upper School Code of Conduct" is an agreement between all Upper School students and school personnel to uphold the mission of our Upper School. This mission is to provide a safe community in an atmosphere that fosters a passion for learning. At Side by Side, discipline is considered to be not only an individual issue, but one concerning the entire school community.

All behavior, actions and conduct that violate the expectations of this code will be subject to a consequence in direct relation to the severity and frequency of the violation. Side by Side will use as a guide, the model of violations and consequences in accordance with the Connecticut State Department of Education.

The Side by Side staff will use a team-oriented approach in dealing with issues concerning student conduct. A team consisting of student family members, teachers, Director, Social Worker and Nurse will work together to look beyond the inappropriate behaviors and actions to seeking the possible causes.

The attached "Code of Conduct" lists examples of conduct which violates our expectations. Each violation is defined and followed by a specific consequence* based on the number of times the offense has occurred. The disciplinary actions of the school are NOT limited to those mentioned in this Code of Conduct.

*Any offense resulting in an "out-of-school" suspension will result in a mandatory family and school personnel meeting with necessary staff, parents and student upon student's arrival back to school.
